





## U13 Cricket vs North Bridge House



On a glorious sunny afternoon at Regent's Park, Portland's Year 7 & 8 cricketers faced North Bridge on an artificial pitch in a 16 over match. Winning the toss, North Bridge elected to bat and their opener was caught leg before in the second over off **Harrison's** pitched-up delivery. In his second over, opening bowler and team captain **Henry** clean bowled their number 2 and after Harrison claimed another in his second over, North Bridge found themselves 23/3.

Henry's third over was his best, taking two consecutive wickets, both clean bowled. Coming after Harrison's wicket this was a team hatrick and a double wicket maiden for the skipper. **Nate** joined the attack and was rewarded on just his third delivery with a superb off stump strike. By this time North Bridge were 25/6 and Portland looked to be very much on top.

It was at this point that Portland let their momentum slip. Some looser bowling allowed the extras total to creep up at a greater rate than would have been ideal. **Joe** took a nice wicket whilst Nate doubled his tally, but by this time North Bridge were 72/8 and looking to post a more respectable score than looked likely after 5 overs.

Bowling the final over, Henry took two more wickets to make it 5 for the innings. His figures were 4 overs, 5 for 15. Superb figures, and he must remember to come and claim the match ball.

As they padded up, PPS were feeling confident, but their spirits soon dipped after opener Henry offered up a simple catch in the first over. Some slow scoring piled pressure on the batsmen and not long after, Nate was bowled for 8, having just got comfortable at the crease. Almost immediately after, PPS lost two wickets for no runs added and found themselves 17/4 and needing Harrison to dig them out of a hole.

With some confident scoring Harrison quickly moved to double figures but was also bowled, much to his frustration, on the last ball of North Bridges best bowler's final over. At this point it looked very unlikely Portland would make the runs with no other batters looking capable of scoring quickly enough.

**Zane** carried his bat for 4, but PPS were bowled out in the 15th over for 57. It was a disappointing result after such a promising start and the squad will need to learn some lessons. They were guilty of taking their foot off the gas having put NBH in all sorts of trouble. Too many extras were given away in the field, whilst key batsmen offered up their wickets too cheaply. North Bridge were far more ruthless and deserved the win.
